A limited number of teams are selected each year with three Hunters on each team. Since the World Musky Hunt is very limited and by invitation only it is one of the most exclusive events in the sport fishing fraternity. The entire purpose of the **WMH** is to promote Musky Fishing in The Greater Minocqua area of northern Wisconsin to the world (it is non-profit, non-commercial, and non-political). It is simply to have fun, meet some great people, while challenging the most frustrating, hard fighting, freshwater fish in the world. That’s what true Musky hunting and sportsmanship is all about.

Over the past 36 years most of our Team Hunters have been Musky Hunting novices and frequently have beginner’s luck. Our World Musky Hunt Guides are renowned for their experience, patience & teaching ability of new Musky Hunters, (*what’s a birds nest?, did you do your figure 8?*) Each team will hunt for Muskies on the Minocqua Chain of Lakes (Lake Minocqua, Kawaquesaga, Mid Lake, Lake Tomahawk, and Little Tomahawk) located in the breath-taking Lakeland Area of the Northwoods of Wisconsin. The Raymond Sloan Center in Lake Tomahawk is the official head-quarters for the World Musky Hunt.(Lodging is available in Minocqua.) REGISTRATION and MEALS

Registration fee is \$300.00 per team member, \$900.00/team**

This covers the cost of meals: Thursday welcome dinner, Friday breakfast and lunch, Saturday breakfast, lunch, victory banquet. The "Official World Musky Hunt History Book", Hunt Trophy, and 2011 WMH Membership. Travel to and from Lake Tomahawk, (If Needed) cash bars, WMH Guide and Greeter.

SPOUSE, FAMILY AND GUEST:

While a Contestant, we welcome and encourage you to bring your spouse, family or guests. We will provide entertainment (*Pontoon Ride*) (*only if we get a min. of 10 people*). You will be expected to bear their expenses.

TRANSPORTATION:

You are expected to provide your own transportation to Lake Tomahawk.

- ✓ Private Plane or Jet: You may land at Lakeland Airport (ARV), Minocqua/Woodruff, WI.
- ✓ Commercial Airlines: Rhinelander (RHI), 25 miles or Wausau (AUW), 80 miles. You will not have to rent a car unless you so desire. We can arrange to have you picked up at the airport, with a weeks notice. Please indicate as to your travel arrangements and whether you will need transportation from the airport and how many persons will need to be picked up.

GUIDES AND GREETERS

All our Guides volunteer their time to help us out with this event. Tipping your Guide is strongly suggested. We would like to keep them happy so they continue to come back year after year to help make the Hunt a success.

Your greeter that is assigned to make sure you are where you need to be and to help make your time at the Hunt very enjoyable is also a volunteer. **While Friday night is a free night for you this is the time we ask that your team takes your greeter out to eat.** Your greeter will usually know the area pretty good and will suggest a great place to eat.

LOCAL TRAVEL:

All automobile transportation will be provided, once you arrive to the event by your guide to and from the Lakes you will be fishing.

EQUIPMENT:

Boats, motors, tackle, Guides, and Greeters will be furnished for you. If you have Musky fishing tackle, bring it along, if not, your WMH Guide will have necessary equipment, baits, etc. for you. All Greeters and Guides are volunteers and are providing (free gratis) their time, experience, boats, equipment, and vehicles.
